<u>President</u> Cathy McCarthy — recapped the board's many accomplishments in 2021.

THE 2022 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There were five (5) open positions on the Board of Directors and five (5) members sent in a Notice of Intent to Serve: Jill Bartholmey, Frank Clarke, Andrea Cooley, Cathy McCarthy, and Steve Rogers. There was no need for an election. The five volunteers constitute the 2022 board.

NEW BUSINESS —

On amending the sign covenant (2.09):

- the "A" section of Cluster 4 contains 37 units, 75% of which is 28 units required to pass the amendment. 29 members within section "A" approved the amendment. The amendment is adopted for residents of Tads Trail.
- The "BCD" section of Cluster 4 contains 62 units, 75% of which is 47 units required to pass the amendment. 43 members within section "BCD" approved the amendment. The amendment is <u>not adopted</u> for residents <u>other than</u> Tads Trail.

67 members voted to waive the year-end financial report. Waived.

Joe Genaro raised landscaping issues for the Property Manager's attention.

- The "BCD" section of Cluster 4 contains 62 units, 75% of which is 47 units required to pass the amendment. 48 members within section "BCD" approved the amendment. The amendment is adopted for residents other than Tads Trail.
