NEW CABLE CONTRACT

The board has recently agreed to a new contract with Spectrum for a 5 (five) year term.

This new contract will expand the services that Spectrum provides our 99 homes within Cluster IV to include:

 Upgraded Cable Service - now instead of basic cable your channel selection will be the Spectrum TV Select PLUS Entertainment View & Sports View & cloud DVR Plus. You will have more channels included, so please check the upgrades you may be paying extra for on your cable bill and adjust your services accordingly so that you will not be overpaying. The channel lineup is available for your review at

- 2. You will still get two cable set top boxes included with your Spectrum bill (additional set top boxes are an additional charge). You will now get a **choice** to add as one of your boxes a DVR set top box with DVR service enabled OR a choice of CLOUD DVR. You are required to install this equipment yourself. You may always contact Spectrum to request professional installation & that may incur additional charges for those services. You must contact Spectrum to schedule if needed.
 - 3. You will now have included with your Spectrum services Wi-Fi services. Known as Advanced Community Wi-Fi Ultra, you will receive one modem & one wireless router. This equipment will be self installed. You may always contact Spectrum to request professional installation & that may incur additional charges for those services. You must contact Spectrum to schedule if needed. Internet speeds noted on our contract are 500 MBPS x 20 MBPS. Residents may request upgrades to this service if needed for additional charges from Spectrum.

When reviewing these services for the community, the board saw this as a way to hopefully reduce costs to everyone by negotiating in these upgrades. Purchasing these items individually, as has been the case prior to this contract, is significantly higher in cost. We will let everyone know when the contract will go into effect with Spectrum. There is a 60 day window for Spectrum to make the necessary changes in their system, so we expect this to be ready for you sometime late August to early September.
