A Meeting of the Board of Directors of East Lake Woodlands Cluster Homes Unit Four Association, Inc. was held via Microsoft Teams, **Sept. 11, 2023 at 6:30pm**.

- Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 6:40 by Cathy McCarthy.
- Calling of the Roll Directors present were Jill Bartholmey, Andrea Cooley, Frank Clarke, Cathy McCarthy, and Steve Rogers. Also present was Peggy Semsey, Property Manager, and Emilio Riera.
- Reading and Disposal of Unapproved Minutes MOVED(Bartholmey/McCarthy) to approve as submitted. Passed unanimously.
- Treasurer's Report Bartholmey: The finances are in good shape. A/R for Maintenance is up \$1,100; cash on hand exceeds \$877K.
- President's Report McCarthy:
  - Asks that we all try to be kind to our neighbors
  - We should all be wary of the danger of car fires
  - Highlighted some pertinent facts about irrigation systems.
- Manager's Report Semsey:
  - No current liens
  - New owner at 10 Tads: Jesse and Mechy Wright III
  - Rec'd one ARC from 10 Tads steps and pavers
  - Final invoices rec'd fro AAA Diversified re 150/160 Evelyn: \$2,950 and \$2,649.02. The door at 150 still needs to be painted and will be handled by John Duro
  - Duro repaired the sill at 280 Tads (\$650) and quoted \$2,530 to repair stucco and T-111
  - AWO installed new street signs (\$225)
  - O'Neil's will grind the stump at 75 Poole; this was not billed originally
  - RedTree:
    - Add'l day of hardwood trimming \$3,000
    - Stump grinding + sod at 10 Tads \$750
    - Sod proposal revised to incl 80 Poole \$16,500
    - Tree removal and stump grinding 70 Evelyn \$1,880
    - Tree flush cut 190 Poole \$1,200
    - Tree flush cut Evelyn center \$1,000
    - Tree removal and stump grinding 30/40 Colette \$1,300
    - Landscape enhancement 160 Evelyn \$1,000

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- The irrigation schedule will be finalized after replacement of the East pressure tank (\$935) and replacement of the East controller (\$2,630). Sprinklers will then adhere to the original published schedule.
- Two quotes rec'd for striping guest parking spaces
- RUST-OFF quoted \$900/mo for 3 wells plus \$800 to remove current rust on sidewalks. Suncoast Rust Control quoted \$535/mo for 3 wells.
- **Unfinished Business** (and motions during reports, if any)
  - 1) Electric meter box replacement deferred one more month
  - 2) Irrigation will be handled this week
  - 3) Parking Guest striping MOVED(McCarthy/Clarke) to drop permanently. Passed unanimously.
  - 4) **Rust control** contract deferred one month

  - 1) ARC applications
    - 1. 10 Tads steps/pavers MOVED(McCarthy/Clarke) to ratify. Passed unanimously.
  - 2) J. Duro quote 280 Tads + 45 Tads MOVED(McCarthy/Clarke) to ratify. Passed unanimously.
  - 3) Sod replacement MOVED(McCarthy/Cooley) to ratify. Passed unanimously.
  - 4) Irrigation controller (East) done.
  - 5) R/T 10 Tads stump grind/sod MOVED(McCarthy/Clarke) to ratify. Passed unanimously.
  - 6) Add'l day of hardwood trimming MOVED(McCarthy/Clarke) to ratify. Passed unanimously.
