Please note that the lawn service will NOT blow off your fenced patio area unless the gate is left open for entrance by the crew. If you want them to clear your patio of debris (leaves, sticks, etc.) with their high powered blowers make sure that your gate is standing open. This is the signal to the crew that you wish to have your patio blown off. If your gate is closed, the crew will NOT enter your patio. You MUST remove items that may be damaged by being blown around: this is a reminder that the blowers being used are very powerful and the crew cannot be responsible for items left on your patio that might blow away and/or break. Also, if you do not want the crew to trim your bushes, please mark your area with a reflector on each end. You can purchase these at any nearby hardware supplier. Marking your bushes will give you the responsibility of trimming your hedges. Thanks to all for your cooperation.
