The amendment to our documents to allow for standard sized signs passed, and we thank all of you who participated in your community governance by voting on this issue. To refresh your memory, below is the new language recorded with our deed restrictions & declarations:

Section 2.09, of the Declaration of Condominium for East Lake Woodlands Cluster Homes Units Four-B, C, & D to read as follows:

(a) Except as otherwise permitted herein, no sign shall be displayed or placed on any Lot, except "For Sale" signs, referring only to the Lot on which displayed, not to exceed four square feet in size, and limited to two signs on that Lot, one in front, one in back, neither illuminated, nor animated or electrified. However, when a Unit is "open for inspection," while that Unit is attended by a representative of the Owner, signs or devices advertising that Unit is open for inspection may be displayed on that Lot. All signs or devices shall be removed immediately after the "open for inspection" event has concluded. Signs required or specifically permitted by law, including building permits and home security system signs, are exempt.

We finished the engineering study and permit approval process to repair the carport structure posts at 170-180 Poole, and work will begin soon. After that is completed, the work to repair the carport sheds will commence.

PALM TREE & TREE TRIMMING

We should have an estimate in hand by the next board meeting in April and hopefully that work will be scheduled sometime soon afterwards.
