As per Florida Statute, Chapter 720.306, Section 9, (b) - A person who is delinquent in the payment of any fee, fine or other monetary obligation to the association for more than 90 days is not eligible for board membership. A person who has been convicted of any felony in this state or in a United States District or Territorial Court, or has been convicted of any offense in another jurisdiction which would be considered a felony if committed in this state, is not eligible for board membership unless such felon's civil rights have been restored for at least 5 years as of the date on which such person seeks election to the board.

New Board Member Certification: Florida Statute 720.3033, The law was amended to provide that, within ninety (90) days after being elected or appointed to the board, each director must submit a certificate of having satisfactorily completed the education curriculum administered by a department approved education provider. The following requirements apply:

- The newly elected or appointed director must complete the department approved education for newly elected or appointed directors within ninety (90) days after being elected or appointed.
- The certificate of completion is valid for up to four (4) years.
- A director must complete the education specific to newly elected or appointed directors at least every four (4) years.
- The department approved education curriculum specific to newly elected or appointed directors must include training relating to financial literacy and transparency, recordkeeping, levying of fines and notice and meeting requirements.

- In addition to the educational curriculum specific to newly elected or appointed directors
 - A director of an association that has fewer than 2,500 parcels must complete at least four (4) hours of continuing education annually.
 - A director of an association that has 2,500 parcels or more must complete at least eight (8) hours continuing education annually.
- The department shall adopt rules to implement and administer the educational curriculum and continued education requirements under this subsection.
